HISTORY

Settlement of the Magna area began in 1851 by Mormon pioneers. Rapid growth came with mining activity at the turn of the century. Magna was established in 1908, and is currently home to approximately 28,000 residents.



MAGNA MAIN STREET

Located at 2700 South, Historic Magna Main Street is the heart of Magna. Though it has seen its share of ups and downs as the fortunes of the copper mine shifted, today Main Street is home to many businesses, civic buildings, and other places of interest.

KENNECOTT COPPER MINE

SALTAIR

The Saltair has undergone many changes as the shores of the lake fluctuated over the last century. In the past it served as a premier resort location, but now is a concert location for touring musical groups. A gift shop and beach access are open during the summer. RECREATION

GREAT SALT LAKE MARINA

For anyone looking to access the waters of the Great Salt Lake the marina located just off Interstate 80 is a great place to come. The marina is home to over 100 sail boats. On weekends you might catch a sail boat or rowing race in action. From the Saltair, travel west to the end of the I-80 frontage road.

LEE CREEK

The Lee Creek area is a 7,000 acre wetland eco-system made of unique salt-loving plants, migratory waterfowl, and billion year old geologic features. A great place to experience the Great Salt Lake! Just minutes from the airport, take I-80 to the 7200 West exit, travel west on the north frontage road for approximately three miles to the parking area.

COPPER GOLF CLUB
